

SSTS Advisory Committee: Application for Membership

The SSTS Advisory Committee advises the agency on revisions to MN Rules chapter 7080, administration of local SSTS ordinances and licensing of SSTS professionals. The committee generally meets quarterly or whenever there is a special need for an additional meeting. The meetings generally held from 9:00 am to 3:00 PM, generally in the St. Cloud area. Travel expenses are paid by the committee member.

Voting members are appointed by the MPCA Commissioner and serve a four-year term, with a maximum of two consecutive terms allowed. Administrators, inspectors, elected officials and contractors must be bona fide residents of Minnesota at least three years before their appointment, and must have at least three years' experience in their respective businesses or offices. The list of voting positions is on the back of this form. Minnesota Rules Chapter 7083.6000 governs the SSTS Advisory Committee and includes attendance requirements. If a member misses three consecutive meetings, or if attendance by the member drops to less than 50% during their term, the member may be replaced.
